

"A friend of mine, Paul Feuerstein, once gave me a very important insight. Paul is the executive director of an organization providing support for people living with disabilities. Monday through Friday, Paul would travel down the FDR from 125th street in Manhattan to East 2nd street. Now if you know anything about Manhattan, you will know that the FDR is always under construction. Paul was reflecting on a passage from Isaiah which is familiar for this time of year. You know the one "Every valley shall be exalted, and every mountain and hill shall be made low; and the crooked shall be made straight, and the rough places plain." And Paul realized that we read these statements as though they only happened once. Valley's exalted, mountains made low, rough places plain. Just like the FDR, these things are always happening. There is no one moment where we stop and say, "ok, now that's done."

Two years ago, I wrote to you in the midst of the pandemic. Last year, I wrote as we began to see a way forward. Today, we have mostly emerged from the trial of COVID only to find ourselves with rising grocery costs, higher heating bills, and no place for families to rent an apartment. The challenge may change but the time remains the same. There are people looking for a place to stay, something to eat, and a friend who will listen. The Nashua Soup Kitchen and Shelter is here to help.
